SCHEDULE B, PART I Requirements

All of the following Requirements must be met:

1. The Proposed Insured must notify the Company in writing of the name of any party not referred to in this Commitment who will obtain an interest in the Land or who will make a loan on the Land. The Company may then make additional Requirements or Exceptions.
2. Pay the agreed amount for the estate or interest to be insured.
3. Pay the premiums, fees, and charges for the Policy to the Company.
4. Documents satisfactory to the Company that convey the Title or create the Mortgage to be insured, or both, must be properly authorized, executed, delivered, and recorded in the Public Records.
5. For each policy to be issued as identified in Schedule A, Item 2, the company shall not be liable under this commitment until it receives a designation for a Proposed Insured, acceptable to the Company. As provided in Commitment Condition 4, the Company may amend the commitment to add, among other things, additional exceptions or requirements after the designation of the Proposed Insured.

- b. and be signed by all the members if management has been retained by the members, or by such managers or other persons as provided in the operating agreement, if said document creates a lower approval threshold.

SCHEDULE B, PART II
Exceptions

THIS COMMITMENT DOES NOT REPUBLISH ANY COVENANT, CONDITION, RESTRICTION, OR LIMITATION CONTAINED IN ANY DOCUMENT REFERRED TO IN THIS COMMITMENT TO THE EXTENT THAT THE SPECIFIC COVENANT, CONDITION, RESTRICTION, OR LIMITATION VIOLATES STATE OR FEDERAL LAW BASED ON RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, SEX, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, GENDER IDENTITY, HANDICAP, FAMILIAL STATUS, OR NATIONAL ORIGIN.

The Policy will not insure against loss or damage resulting from the terms and provisions of any lease or easement identified in Schedule A, and will include the following Exceptions unless cleared to the satisfaction of the Company:

1. Any defect, lien, encumbrance, adverse claim, or other matter that appears for the first time in the Public Records or is created, attaches, or is disclosed between the Commitment Date and the date on which all of the Schedule B, Part I—Requirements are met.
2. Rights or claims of parties in possession not shown by the public records.
3. Easements of claims of easements, not shown by the public records.
4. Any encroachment, encumbrance, violation, variation, or adverse circumstance affecting the Title that would be disclosed by an accurate and complete land survey of the Land.
5. Any lien or right to a lien, for services, labor, or material heretofore or hereafter furnished, imposed by law and not shown by the public records.

Beginning at a found nail at the Southeast corner of Section 12; thence along the East line of said section N01°-15'-14"E 58.85 to a found nail at the Southwest corner of Section 7, Township 61 North, Range 8 West; continue thence N01°-53'-35"E 1674.76 ft. to a set iron rod at the point of beginning; thence leaving said line N85°-51'-13"W 1123.53 ft. to a set iron rod; thence N01°-49'-25"E 868.63 ft. to a found iron rod on the North line of the Southeast Quarter of said section; thence along said north quarter section line N88°-30'-53"W 197.32 ft. to a found iron rod at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of said quarter section; thence leaving said line along the West line of said quarter quarter N01°-47'-21"E 1325.43 ft. to a found iron at the Northwest corner of said quarter quarter; thence leaving said line S88°-43'-12"E 1323.50 ft. to a set iron rod at the Northeast corner of said quarter quarter; thence leaving said line along the East line of said section S01°-53'-35"W 2250.99 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 63.37 acres. Subject to any and all easements, conditions, restrictions, etc. of record.
